



# Amtrak Fact Sheet, Fiscal Year 2004

## State of Arizona

### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates three long-distance trains through Arizona:

- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Los Angeles via Flagstaff)
- The *Sunset Limited* (tri-weekly Orlando-New Orleans-Tucson-Los Angeles)
- The *Texas Eagle* (daily Chicago-Dallas-San Antonio with through car service tri-weekly via the *Sunset Limited* to Los Angeles, with stops in Benson, Tucson, Maricopa, and Yuma)

During FY04 Amtrak served the following Arizona locations:

### Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak expended \$952,736 for goods and services in Arizona in FY04. Most of this money was spent in Scottsdale, \$911,416.

### Employment

During fiscal year 2004, Amtrak employed 36 Arizona residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Arizona were \$1,561,816 during this period.

### Station Features

At Williams Junction, Amtrak has a connection with the Grand Canyon Railway, which offers rail packages to the rim of the Grand Canyon.
