Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates two long-distance trains through Colorado:

- The *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Denver- Emeryville/Bay Area)
- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Kansas City-La Junta-Trinidad-Albuquerque-Los Angeles)

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak expended \$18,998,202 for goods and services in Colorado in FY04. Most of this money was spent in Denver, \$18,715,838.

Employment

During fiscal year 2004, Amtrak employed 94 Colorado residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Colorado were \$5,558,480 during this period.
