Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates four long-distance trains through Georgia:

- The *Crescent* (daily New York-Atlanta-New Orleans)
- The *Palmetto* (daily New York-Savannah via Charleston, S.C.)
- The *Silver Meteor* (New York-Savannah-Miami via Charleston, S.C.)
- The *Silver Star* (daily New York-Savannah-Miami via Columbia, S.C.)

Employment

At the end of FY07, Amtrak employed 55* Georgia residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Georgia were \$2,930,382* during FY07.
