Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates two long-distance trains through Iowa:

- The *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Burlington-Denver-Salt Lake City-Emeryville/Bay Area)
- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Fort Madison-Kansas City-Los Angeles)

During FY05 Amtrak served the following Iowa locations, which had a 12.9% increase over FY04:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak expended \$1,697,374 for goods and services in Iowa in FY05. Most of this money was spent in Council Bluffs, \$1,464,312.

Employment

During fiscal year 2005, Amtrak employed 13 Iowa residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Iowa were \$830,985 during this period.
